Birding – Strandfontein Sewerage Works

Recently there has been much excitement among the twitchers with various new sightings occurring at the Strandfontein Sewerage Works. One such sighting causing much excitement was that of the Temminck's Stint (Calidris temminckii). The Temminck's Stint has not been officially recorded in South Africa for more than 25 years, with approximately 5 records ever for the sub-region! According to many, the best time to see this species at Strandfontein is in the morning.

Other special birds currently at Strandfontein are the Pectoral & Terek sandpipers (Calidris melanotos & Xenus cinereus), American golden plover (Pluvialis dominica), red-

necked phalarope (*Phalaropus lobatus*), and another regional rarity - Baillon's crake (*Porzana pusilla*).


