In process of purchasing two belt presses to begin dewatering the digested sludge due(Mid Aug-Sep) **FBNR Report back** Draw down report: The Zeekoevlei weir was opened on the 27th April 2016. 77 resident's shoreline plans with renewals by end of the year. A grab truck and driver was borrowed from Zandvlei to remove litter and reeds. 101 tons of reeds were removed from Zeekoevlei, Nature cons. managed to collect all reed piles. 6000 black bags were used for litter. Hyacinth follow up for big lotus, Bottom road end had some hyacinth spotted. Weir was closed off by the 8th July. DG's home owner's manual to be edited and published by DG;JVE JVF. Book should then be issued to all 7eekoevlei residents. SG - Suggested we look at getting the Home Owner's manual sponsored, and similar manuals for other reserves bordering a residential area. Conservation status – 17th May proclaimed as a significant date as the Act for Reserves was signed. (Proclaimed under the National Legislation) Zeekoevlei section: The past two years had visitors number increased. Last quarter over 5000 visitors had entered. The Eastern Shore is currently being managed by two permanent staff members. VD;AK SG: Try and attach the reserve visitor stats table in the future report. AR – The landfill site is a proclaimed area with ground water linked to it DG; Management plans for protected areas are completed but do not include the sewage works. Non cleaning of landfill should be reported via a chain of commands AR asked; is there a committee of local residents for waste water treatment works? DG responded; there is no need for a Waste Water Treatment committee. • SG – PAAC should nominate Anthony as the rep for landfill site i.e.: WWTW committee meeting • Reports of Mallards in Strandfontein area, needs to be removed. Affecting the protected area. RC - Can we add papyrus to mallard problem? Who do we ask to report?

The R.O.D regarding the dredging of Zeekoevlei expires in Feb/March 2017. It was renewed for 5 years when it was about to expire after the first 3 years, so 8 years and nothing has happened and its about to expire again. A number of options exist - renew again - Can it be renewed; check whether it can to be renewed for another 5 years; - activate the R.O.D. by beginning the work (we need to find out what this entails) SG - On behalf of JJ, agreed that we should start action before it lapses. Threat of losing jurisdiction EIA Should plan ahead accordingly so far it has not been actioned due to lack of funds Dredging needs to be on the agenda of the new (postelection) Mayco of CoCT.
