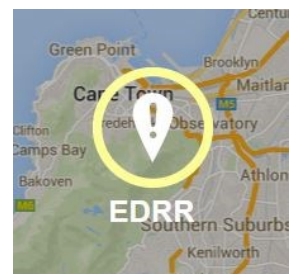

# Why all the fuss?

Preventing the introduction of Invasive species is the first line of defence against invasions. The second line of defence is early detection and rapid response (EDRR). The Spotter Network aims to collect information on the location of targeted invasive species before the population has established itself and become harder to control.

## What do I do?
